Foodways	Plant and animal foods	Activities
<i>Hunt</i>	<i>Deer, elk, turkey, waterfowl</i>	<i>Travel to get rock to make spear points, knives, and scrapers; locate wild animals; kill animals; transport animals back to camp; butcher animals; cook meat</i>
<i>Gather/collect</i>	<i>Hickory nuts, goodsefoot leaves, acorns, sunflower seeds</i>	<i>Travel to locate seasonal plants; pick nuts and berries; shell nuts; grind nuts into meal; parch nuts; store nuts; dry berries; prepare food; cook food</i>
<i>Fish/collect</i>	<i>Fish, turtle, shellfish</i>	<i>Make nets; make fishing hooks; make fishing line; fish; find and pick up turtles; prepare fish; cook meat</i>
