Hunt	Deer, elk, turkey, waterfowl	Travel to get rock to make spear points, knives, and scrapers; locate wild animals; kill animals; transport animals back to camp; butcher animals; cook meat
Gather/collect	Hickory nuts, goodsefoot leaves, acorns, sunflower seeds	Travel to locate seasonal plants; pick nuts and berries; shell nuts; grind nuts into meal; partch nuts; store nuts; dry berries; prepare food; cook food
Fish/collect	Fish, turtle, shellfish	Make nets; make fishing hooks; make fishing line; fish; find and pick up turtles; prepare fish; cook meat
